Totus Tuus Catholic Summer Youth Camp is coming to St. Anthony's June 25th-30th






Holy Land Pilgrimage with God's Embrace Ministries

Last Sunday morning, during announcements towards the end of Mass, I, Deacon Rick, made an announcement promoting Serenity's "Baby Bottle Boomerang Fund-raiser." In that announcement, I used a statistical comparison of deaths from wars with deaths from abortion. Several parishioners asked for a copy of those statistics; her they are. Deacon Rick

Abortions since Roe vs Wade:

U.S. since 1973 = 63 million total World since 1973 = 73 million per year

Vietnam wall

246' 8" long with 58,318 names - 80 yards on a football field.

236 names per foot. Using that number of names per foot, there would be:

1,246,080 names per mile

A WWII wall would be almost 1/3 rd of a mile long.

A wall depicting the 63,000,000 abortions in the USA since 1973, the wall would be 50.5 miles.

A wall depicting the 3,650,000,000 abortions world-wide for last 50 years (since 1973) would be a wall 2,929 miles long.

That wall could stretch from Seattle, WA. to Our Lady of Guadalupe Basilica near Mexico City; it would be 2,834 miles long!

Ironically, the world population in 1973 was 3,920,000,000 people

the number of abortions since 1973 has been 3,650,000,000!

To me, this horrible reality is even more horrific because this wall for the 3,650,000,000 babies murdered in the womb, or just outside of it, has **NO NAMES** on it.

They were not even given the dignity of having a name.

WHAT CAN WE DO ABOUT IT? Weaponize these baby bottles and support our communities efforts. Change hearts and minds and "Save one life at a time!"
